How to participate:

- Hang your towel to reuse it. If you are happy to reuse your towels, please hang them on the towel rack. This indicates that you do not require a fresh towel today.
- Place towels on the floor for replacement. If you would like fresh towels, leave them on the bathroom floor, and housekeeping will replace them.
